Investment in ARPAC, a Brazilian agricultural drone startup

Drone Fund II (Official name; Chiba Dojo Drone Fund II Investment Limited Partnership), managed by Kotaro Chiba and Soki Ohmae in Tokyo, Japan, has invested in the agricultural drone solutions company, ARPAC, managed by Eduardo da Costa Goerl in Rio Grande do Sul, Brazil.

Points of this investment

- 1. Drone Fund invests in a drone startup specializing in the agricultural market of Brazil, the 3rd largest agricultural exporter in the world.
- 2. This is the first investment in Latin America for Drone Fund.

1. ABOUT THIS INVESTMENT

Brazil is the third largest agricultural exporter in the world (after the EU and the United States) and is the world's number one producer of sugarcane and coffee (*1). Specifically, the advantages of labor saving and efficiency improvement by introducing precision farming is invaluable in farmland where manpower is indispensable; such as large sugarcane and coffee plantations located on sloping land.

ARPAC, established in Brazil in 2014, has been developing drone spraying solutions of pesticide and insects for sugarcane fields and coffee plantations since 2018. ARPAC is one of the leading companies of Brazil's agribusiness acceleration. Its solution is about 80 times faster than manual work at the same cost.

This is the first investment in Latin America through the Drone Fund I and II. In Japan, the use of commercial drones in agriculture has long been expected. A forecast says that it will account for 20% of the commercial drone service market of Japan by 2024 (*2). With this investment in a drone startup from a major agricultural country, we will continue to work on the realization of a drone-based society on a global scale.
